At first they acted like they were there for me but after months and months of no help or support.. I quickly found out they do not care about the average worker. They simply would not look at the evidence and made any excuse to keep me denied or able to get any help whatsoever. They knew I was severely injured. Not just a small short term injury but a long term problem. They never had any intentions of helping me at all. They seemed to want to make matters worse by applying whatever strategy to keep me on the line and desperate for help. This caused such a financial burden I lost everything including my home.

You'd think they have a conscience but they do not. I think they should be held accountable for the damage they have personally caused me and so many others. It is not a game and they think it is. They do not apply the act and any given time.. and try to use the parts that simply support their claims to not be responsible. I was injured from work when I was 21 and now I am 38.. I will live with the damage caused from my previous employer for my entire life. It's sad to think a hard young worker would be treated that way but we all know that this is what they do when they want to keep the money owed to so many people. I find they are one of the most corrupt extentions of the government. At first they denied I was hurt at all then they used all sorts of excuses when they found out how injured I really was. I feel they new everything from the start as my job was not an easy one. I ask you what is the point of them if they are simply an illusion done to people to make them believe the are protected? As for me.. how can I ever find employment with a ruined back? The side effects of such damage are very wide and everyday is a struggle for me. I can not believe they would rather people die of their injuries than help out a fellow human being. I lost all hope in the systems and I don't think I will ever trust a government agency ever again. My suggestion is they actually apply the act and take responsibility no matter how much they may owe someone for compensation. They know that a case like mine is worth multiple thousands and they would rather keep it for themselves. Probably for taking trips with while the people they owe are left to suffer in silence.

There is no reason they should be aloud to destroy lives, deny people their rights, and cause damage often as sever as the injuries themselves. I hope that they will be forced to change and admit wrong doing but like they've told me and my familly... "there's is nothing I can do" "we have a building full of lawyers who will make sure you never get paid." "Give it up"

If you truly want to help the system?.. maybe they should start with cases like mine and give the

support they should have so many years ago. Not only is it unlikely I will ever have a job again.. if I were to ever get hurt or worsen my injuries from an employment.. they would simply deny me my rights once again only to have my life completely ruined.

I hope this makes sense to you and that you understand how serious this matter really is.. I'm just one person but I know they do this to many many people.
