TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

A POINT TO CONSIDER IS THAT SHOULD A WORKER BECOME PERMANENT DISABLED WHILE WORKING AT AGE (18) EIGHTEEN, HE OR SHE COULD RECEIVE BENEFIT UNTIL THE AGE OF (65) SIXTY-FIVE. HOWEVER A WORKER INJURED AT AGE (65) SIXTY-FIVE OR OLDER WOULD ONLY BE ALLOWED TO RECEIVE BENEFIT FOR (4) FOUR YEARS FROM THE TIME OF INJURY.

IN THE WORLD OF TODAY RETIREMENT AT (65) SIXTY-FIVE DOES NOT HAPPEN IN ALL CASES IN PARTICULAR CONSTRUCTION, TRUCK DRIVING, OPERATORS, ETC. YOUR CONSIDERATION TO THE ABOVE WOULD BE APPRECIATED.
